Hello Cornerstone,

I hope this message finds you well. I am reaching out to extend my **utmost gratitude** for doing what you do, especially running your Food Cupboard!

I recently left the hospital due to acute kidney injury after trying to end my life due to Eastern Connecticut State University (ECSU) retaliating against me for reporting being sexually assaulted and the Connecticut State Colleges & Universities (CSCU) System protecting them.

I am stranded at the TA in Willington, CT, and last night, someone who you gave food to from the Food Cupboard spared me something from their batch after I told them I was about to collapse due to starvation. They told me about how well you have treated them! I am currently waiting for my SNAP benefits EBT card and will likely end up asking DSS to send the card to the Post Office in Willington via General Delivery. I will then walk to the Post Office, since due to CSCU and ECSU "starving me out," my car insurance is now cancelled. They blocked my unemployment saying that I quit when in fact, they fired me via criminal trespass warning.

In fact, as I type this, I am woozy and feel like I am going to collapse again. Even still, I hold out hope that I will be able to obtain food somehow. I wholeheartedly back your mission - to ensure that **no one** ever goes hungry or without shelter, alongside the wellbeing of all humans.

I pray 🙏 that one day, I can be a part of the mission to end hunger and homelessness in Connecticut, and when I win my settlement with the CT Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities, I will donate to Cornerstone.

Again, thank you for what you do and may you have many years of generosity ahead of you. You are the true heroes and for that, I am ever so grateful. I have copied the office of Governor Ned Lamont on this email - while all of my emails to his office up to this point have been about failure points, I want to make it known that **I pay attention to where Connecticut gets it right too!**

Governor Lamont, thank you for doing what you can! I know it can be tough with limited funding, which is why we will **continue to lobby for human rights!** ⚖️
