Hello Kimberly,

I hope this message finds you well. I am reaching out because I am in dire need of food and shelter. I was recently released from the hospital with acute kidney injury and I am stuck at the TA truck stop in Willington, CT because my car insurance is cancelled.

I would love to make it to your soup kitchen to eat but I have no means to do so right now - is there any way you can help me with this? I am literally about to collapse from hunger - this is because Eastern Connecticut State University fired me after being sexually assaulted and then blocked my unemployment.

I also need help with a mailing address. Your website mentions that you have USPS Delivery Services. Can we get me connected with your advocacy services? I have nowhere to sleep or shower and I have not bathed in days. The only thing is that I am too traumatized and too sick to share a room - are there any single-room/respite options available?

Please note that I will be posting this email to you on my website as evidence for my case with the CT Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities - I commented on your Instagram Thanksgiving post from my Justice For Title IX Survivors account - you can find the link to my website in my profile. I have also copied the CHRO Norwich Office on this email - CHRO, please add this to my file for my current case against Connecticut State Colleges & Universities.

Thank you, Kimberly and CHRO, for your help. I am ever so grateful for any help you can provide. You are true heroes.
