Hello Project HOPE,

I hope this message finds you well. I am reaching out because I am in dire need of food and shelter. I already contacted Kimberly Clark over at Covenant Soup Kitchen. I was recently released from the hospital with acute kidney injury (I also lost 30+ pounds since September due to starvation) and I am stuck at the TA truck stop in Willington, CT because my car insurance is cancelled.

Is there any way you can help me with transportation or money in general? **Eastern Connecticut State University** fired me after being sexually assaulted and then blocked my unemployment, and I have had trouble finding work. I also have no way to pay for laundry.

I have nowhere to sleep or shower and I have not bathed in days. The only thing is that I am too traumatized and too sick to share a room - are there any single-room/respite options available?

Please note that I will be posting this email to you on my website as evidence for my case with the CT Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities. I have also copied the **CHRO Norwich Office** on this email - **CHRO, please add this to my file for my current case against Connecticut State Colleges & Universities.**
